**\*2017 Haiti Mission Trip: Haiti Homes** – Pastor McDonald has set a goal for the church to raise funds to build two permanent block homes – a total of \$13,200 is needed (\$6,600 per home). \$360 was contributed this past week for a total of \$8,341. If you want to give, please take an offering envelope, mark "Haiti Homes," enclose your gift, and place it in the collection plate.

**Suitcases Needed** – Haiti does not have a reliable delivery system so all supplies and food must be taken with those going on the trip. A number of large suitcases are still needed (preferably on wheels), and the suitcases will be left in Haiti. Please bring any suitcases you can donate to the church.

**Food Needed** – A variety of food is needed by the Haiti Missions Team to take with them on their trip. Some of the food is required for the group to bring for their meals and the remainder of the food will be used by Mission of Hope Haiti. For those who took a tag from the wall last week, please return the items you are donating to the "Haiti" tubs in the lobby by next Sunday, June 4th. If you didn't take a tag and still want to help, please see Jennifer Peace or Teri McDonald.

**Final Payment** – For those going on the trip, final payment is due by Sunday, June 18th.

**\*Operation Christmas Child:** Samaritan's Purse works with local churches to deliver shoe boxes filled with gifts to children around the world. Beginning today, we will be collecting bar soap for the next two weeks. A schedule of the items being collected for the next couple of months is available at the Welcome Desk.

The congregation has been challenged to pray about the number of the boxes to be sent from the church for 2017. For the past two years, 1,500 shoe boxes were sent each year. Minimally, \$13,500 will be needed for postage (\$9 per box). This past week, \$196 was given for a total of \$7,323. If you can help, please take an offering envelope, mark "Shoe Box," enclose your gift, and place it in the collection plate. Any items being donated can be left in the red tubs in the lobby.
