### **\*2017 Haiti Mission Trip: Haiti Homes – The goal has been met!!**

\$13,200 has been raised to build two permanent block homes. Any additional monies received will go toward other projects through Mission of Hope Haiti such as the Church Repair Fund that helps churches make needed repairs to their buildings. Thank you to everyone who has given to the homes.

**Supplies Needed** – Along with the food going to Haiti, there will be some additional room in the suitcases to take items that can be utilized by the variety of ministries in which the Mission of Hope takes part. A flyer is available with the needed items at the Welcome Desk. Please place any donations in the Haiti collection bins in the lobby through next Sunday, July 23rd.

**Trip Meeting** – There will be a meeting for those going on the trip on Sunday, July 30th, following the Evening Service in the WOW Class.

**\*Operation Christmas Child:** Samaritan's Purse works with local churches to deliver shoe boxes filled with gifts to children around the world. We are collecting sunglasses this week. Beginning next Sunday, we will be collecting pens, pencils, and sharpeners.

The congregation has been challenged to pray about the number of the boxes to be sent from the church for 2017. For the past two years, 1,500 shoe boxes were sent each year. Minimally, \$13,500 will be needed for postage (\$9 per box). This past week, \$320 was given for a total of \$9,238.
