**\*Operation Christmas Child:** Samaritan's Purse works with local churches to deliver shoe boxes filled with gifts to children around the world. Beginning today, we will be collecting hair brushes for the next two weeks.

The congregation has been challenged to pray about the number of the boxes to be sent from the church for 2017. For the past two years, 1,500 shoe boxes were sent each year. Minimally, \$13,500 will be needed for postage (\$9 per box). This past week, \$331 was given for a total of \$13,812 so the minimal amount needed for postage has been reached!! If more boxes are prepared, we will need additional postage.

Along with the postage, there are some other expenses including the purchase of shoe boxes from Samaritan's Purse for the 2 to 4-year-old boys and girls and there may be a need to purchase additional items for the boxes.

If you can help, please take an offering envelope, mark "Shoe Box," enclose your gift, and place it in the collection plate. Any items being donated can be left in the red tubs in the lobby.
