**Souls saved**

At the end of January, we had 2 souls saved in the church in Chisinau and Balti. Rasheet, a Moldovan Muslim who is a shepherd by trade, came to the church as a result of our street ministry. His father, a Turk, raised him Muslim. After hearing the gospel, he made the choice that Mohammed was not his God, but that Jesus Christ is his God! Praise the Lord, he came forward and bowed his head and trusted Jesus Christ as Savior! It was a blessing to my heart to see this man, who has spent most of his life with sheep put His faith in The “Good Shepherd” the Lord Jesus Christ! In the Balti church, Oleg came and trusted Jesus Christ as Savior as a result of our street work there. Please pray the fruit abounds.



**Revival Services**

This last month we had revival services with Pastor David Peacock and 10 people from Bible Believers Baptist Church in Jacksonville, Florida. They were a blessing to our ministry here, and encouraged our churches, pastors and other leaders to continue in the grace of God.

We started revival in Slobozia-Recea about 3 hours north of our home. When we arrived at the village of 150 homes, the people were packed in the home of culture building waiting for us. You could sense God was working in people’s hearts as we started singing. You could see the tired weathered faces of the villagers, but you could see their eagerness to hear the word of God. After the preaching, 5 souls received Jesus Christ as Savior! It brought great joy to my heart watching people leave with the hope of salvation.



On Tuesday we arrived in Prednistrovia Slobodzia, after a long hold up at the border. KJB agents came on the bus to examine documents to make sure they were in order. We proceeded to the church in Slobodzia. It was a blessing seeing old faces we had led to the Lord 20 years ago still being faithful to the Lord. Artiom, a young man now married, was in the service. It was a blessing for Susan and I to see him and to hear about his wife and family. It blessed our hearts to know that the church is still working even though we are not there. Brother Costia and family were great hosts. Pastor Peacock preached on Wells. You could see the



people were really thinking about their condition. After the preaching, 5 more souls trusted Jesus as Savior. From there we left to go to the village of Crasnea. When we arrived at the old farm house, people were packed in a huge garage silo where they store crops. The children blessed our hearts as they prepared songs in English for the American group. There were also 5 souls saved as a result of the preaching. The American ladies served the villagers with hot tea and cookies; it was a blessed time of fellowship.

On Wednesday we traveled to our city church in Balti, we were met with a packed room filled with people. Pastor Andrea played his accordion and we sang Hymns and the Lord began to work in people's hearts. There were 4 new young people who visited the church, and a gypsy family of 5. After the preaching, God saved the whole family of gypsies. We rejoice at the salvation of souls and the fruit God brought as a result of prayers and the preaching of God's Word.

Finally, in Chisinau Pastor Peacock preached and helped our people in so many ways. It was a blessing being around him and learning from him. As a result of the preaching, 2 people walked the aisle and trusted Jesus Christ as Savior. One of the ladies, Marina, a mother of 6 without a husband, left with the joy of Lord, knowing she was not alone anymore and that through Christ she could live and raise her children for the glory of God. Please continue to pray that God would help these souls to continue in the grace of God.

### **Purified Word Printing International**

Prior to the group coming, we were able to print 9,000 Gospel of Johns and over 40,000 tracts. We also received the translation of the Jack Chick book (Macedonian) King of Kings and also "This Was Your Life" from Brother Luke Svetcova, translated from the King James Bible. Luke continues to finish the proof reading of the Macedonian Bible. Please pray for us as we make preparations for printing these and a summer mission trip to Macedonia.
