Although Satan's hold on people here is extremely strong, we are seeing signs that what is happening is causing many hearts to be more open to the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ. All three churches that we work with have very active soul-winning programs. It is not uncommon for more than half of the church members to participate. We are thankful that these churches were started on a soul-winning foundation and have faithfully continued on that course.

Recently missions conferences have challenged the people to give more and to do more for missions. In spite of the horrible economy, Faith Promise goals have been raised and we are beginning to see monthly goals being exceeded. The churches have either taken on new missionaries or are making plans to do so. What a blessing to see God's people putting the Lord first in their finances.

In the course of our ministries, we drive well over a thousand miles a month on all kinds of roads. The Lord has given us total safety and protection in our travels. Our car now has over 275,000 miles on it and the Lord keeps it running great. We now have mechanics on both sides of the border that go out of their way to keep it running smoothly. We are grateful to the Lord that He is always at our side, even in our car as we travel. We have learned that the safest place for a child of God on this earth is in the center of His perfect will.
