**Operation Christmas Child:** Samaritan's Purse works with local churches to deliver shoeboxes filled with gifts to children around the world. We are collecting sunglasses this week. Beginning next Sunday, we will be collecting hair ties and accessories.

**Postage Update** – This year, we plan to pack at least 1,800 shoeboxes so we will need \$18,000 for postage (\$10 per box). This past week, \$3,694 was given for a total of \$9,446.

**Soccer Ball Update** – This year, we plan to put a soccer ball with a pump in each box for the 5 to 9-year-old boys (250 boxes) and 10 to 14-year-old boys (400 boxes). The current cost is around \$6 for each soccer ball with a pump so we will need \$3,900. This past week, \$15 was given for a total of \$1,233 in this fund.

Campsites include Full-Service (electrical hook up) and Modern (tent camping). Cabins can sleep from 3-4 to 8 people and are available with or without electricity. Full-Service sites must be reserved for a minimum of 5 nights. Dogs aren't permitted in the cabins. 2024 rates: Full-Service Back-In -\$170/week;

Cabins, \$65 & above per night. The camp can be contacted for fees for other sites (Full-Service Pull-Through and Modern-Tent Camping). There is a \$10 fee per reservation. Please note that all deposits are non-refundable (camping credits are issued and can be used within one year). For more information, please call the Church Office.
